Abstract: Does oil hinder democracy? Dr. Hendrix's studies and statistical modeling find that the oil curse is a function not just of international market conditions but geopolitical dynamics as well.

Dr. Hendrix is Associate Professor at the Korbel School of International Studies, University of Denver, and Nonresident Senior Fellow at the Peterson Institute for International Economics. He published *Confronting the Curse: The Economics and Geopolitics of Natural Resource Governance* (with Marcus Noland, 2014).
